RECITAL COSTUMES

Recital costumes are \$75.00 plus tax (\$81.75) per class. This amount should cover the cost of the majority of the costumes ordered; however, if there is a balance or credit, it will be applied in January.

Costumes have been posted to all students accounts. They are due on October 1st and late after the 15th. If we do not have your payment on or before October 15th, a costume will not be ordered for your dancer on the first order. Please note that costumes not ordered on our "first" order will most likely NOT be here in time for recital photo week. We urge you to have payment in on time, as it puts children and parents in an embarrassing situation when their costume is not here for photo week.

Ballet & Tap K classes will have a "2 in 1" costume this year.

If your child cannot perform in a recital dance, you **MUST** fill out a **NO COSTUME ORDER FORM** in the studio office(attached). If your child is taking more than one level of a subject, she/he may perform in both recital classes, or just their regular level. If she/he chooses to perform in only one, it will automatically be the class level in which she/he was placed from last year. If performing in only one, be sure to fill out a **NO COSTUME ORDER FORM** in the office for the other class that she/he will not be performing with.

Acrobatics classes will **NOT** be in the recital, but instead will have a demonstration here at the studio during the last week of classes.
